

LYON debeaker

The Lyon debeaker is recognized and used throughout the world as the only proven reliable and safe method to stop cannibalism, picking, fighting and egg loss.

At 6 weeks of age hens are usually debeaked on a beak support, which is a crossbar. The beak is positioned on the support, and the blade cuts through the beak with the cutting edge striking the beak support. At a younger age birds are generally debeaked by use of a gauge plate, a thin, stainless steel plate with a hole through which the beak is inserted. The blade moves behind the plate thereby cutting the beak.
